Dumped rubbish

From a few black bags to piles of furniture, rubbish makes areas look unattractive and can quickly get out of control.

What we do

- Each year we collect any dumped rubbish we see, plus over 25,000 'fly-tips' reported by you.
- We clear 90% of these within 24 hours.*
- We issue fines to anyone caught and prosecute people and businesses who illegally dump their rubbish on our streets.



*Camden Council only removes dumped rubbish from council-owned land.

What you can do

- See it? Report it.
- Report dumped rubbish free on the Love Clean Streets app.



Bulky rubbish collections

- Free collections of reusable furniture
- Free collections of large electrical items and white goods
- Special collections for large household items to be disposed of

To improve the look of and protect an affected area, you could:

- Create a flower bed or add hanging baskets
- Place a seating area for people to rest
- Add a solar night lighting scheme
- Paint a mural or new artwork.
