The Covid-19 pandemic has changed how communities in Camden live, travel and work. We want our streets to have **more safe space** for everyone to walk and cycle, for children to get to and from school **safely and healthily**, for you to be **breathing cleaner air**, to **reduce carbon emissions** from vehicles and for businesses to **flourish**.

We want to ensure that our streets support a strong recovery from the pandemic and provide a lasting legacy of **greener, safer and healthier travel**.



The changes to Warren Street

Last year we created new Streateries across Camden by creating new spaces in the road to allow cafes and restaurants to serve customers outside. These Streateries are helping the hospitality sector recover from the pandemic, supporting the reopening of our high streets and town centres and keeping communities safe by providing extra space people to move around.


We've been trialling changes on Warren Street outside No. 25 to 28 to help make streets safer and healthier by removing parking bays and providing outdoor dining areas on the road leaving pavements clear for people to pass by.



We are now consulting on continuing the trial measures on Warren Street as follows:

- Outside nos. 25 – 28: Providing 27 metres of space for outdoor dining in an area which was previously 11 metres of resident parking bay and 16 metres single yellow line and
- Retaining the pedestrian and cycle zone with emergency vehicle access only from the west (near junction with Fitzroy Street).
