



Key developments

Key developments affecting Fitzrovia in the next five years:







1

Tottenham Court Road, Crossrail

The Elizabeth line will stretch from Reading to Heathrow in the west and to Shenfield and Abbey Wood in the east, resulting in an extra 1.5 million people within 45 minutes of central London.

The £14.8 billion investment will carry an estimated 200 million passengers per year with 41 stations and 24 trains per hour in each direction.

2

The West End Project

The West End Project is Camden Council's £35 million public realm project which will transform the heart of the West End making it more attractive for residents, workers and visitors while boosting the local economy.

The project saw the introduction of permanent 2-way traffic flow for all vehicles and cyclists on Gower Street and restricted access on sections of Tottenham Court Road at set times.

3

Oxford Street District

The first phase of the overarching Oxford Street District strategy involves plans to install a temporary scheme on Oxford Street itself, with the aim of showcasing innovation, sustainability, culture and diversity.

The planned temporary changes will make Oxford Street more exciting and attractive to visitors and residents, increasing dwell time and creating a more vibrant experience.

Tottenham Court Road station will see more than

High Speed 2 (HS2)

Phase one: London to West Midlands 2026

High Speed 2 is a planned high-speed railway connecting London with the major cities in the north of the United Kingdom. Euston is the station where HS2 trains will begin and terminate their journeys and will undergo a transformation with the addition of 11 new platforms and a reconfiguration of the surrounding area.

Commercial and Retail Developments

There are a number of commercial and mixed-use developments underway in Fitzrovia including: Arthur Stanley House, Tottenham Street; The Workhouse, Cleveland Street and Tottenham Mews; 247 Tottenham Court Road.





Air quality in London improved during the Covid-19 pandemic which accelerated the need to implement clean air initiatives. We work as a partner of Cross River Partnership, Camden Climate Change Alliance (CCCA) and support the Mayor of London's initiatives.



Air Quality



The Fitzrovia Partnership supports the Mayor of London and Camden Council's sustainability initiates such as Camden Climate Change Alliance (CCCA) and Transport for London's Efficient Deliveries workshops. It is actively helping businesses to make positive changes to the area's air quality by developing bespoke actions plans.

The Partnership has been awarded with 'Highly Commended' for improving Air Quality in Camden and Islington Sustainability Awards.



Placemaking and Streetscape



The Fitzrovia Partnership vision is to increase walking and cycling through enhanced connectivity and transformed public realm; to create a safer, inclusive environment for all through improved streetscape design; to create a healthier environment through the promotion of sustainable transport alternatives and delivering mitigation to

Green Infrastructure



The Fitzrovia Partnership invests in green infrastructure and identifies opportunities for urban greening in the area to support sustainable working in the area. We work with businesses and building owners to support a vision for window boxes. planters and hanging baskets across the area. The Fitzrovia Partnership will continue to build on successes to date throughout 2020.

FitzPark

As a trial, FitzPark transformed a delivery bay into a pop-up park containing seating and planting for public use. Set up to promote health and wellbeing in the area, foster community interaction, improve the look and feel and increase biodiversity, it had outstanding results.



2019 Awards: Highly Commended in 'Improving Air Quality' at Camden and Islington Sustainability Awards Winner of the 'Design of a Temporary Landscape' at Landscape Institute Awards. Designed by Arup, the initial project was funded by The Fitzrovia Partnership with additional funding secured by Clean Air Better Business (CABB) from the Mayor's Air Quality Fund.

#Fitzpark has now been relocated to Fitzroy Street at the junction with Warren Street and has reduced reported Flytipping and Anti Social Behaviour in this area by 98%.

By using one office stationery supplier, we have substantial buying power to negotiate preferential rates while consolidating deliveries to the area. We have identified that the number of vehicles delivering office supplies in Fitzrovia can be reduced by up to 75% by 2020.

The purpose of the Street Wardens is to provide a uniformed presence to safeguard visitor and business wellbeing. They monitor the street environment and work closely with our businesses, the police and agencies to help deter crime and anti-social behaviour and reduce the fear of crime.

They assist with:

- signposting visitors
- assisting the homeless and displaced individuals
- working with and updating the authorities
- reducing crime, antisocial behaviour and improving general area safety
- event management
- rapid response for local businesses.

Our street warden team is provided by My Local Bobby who are experts in creating a safe and secure neighbourhood, free from crime and anti-social behaviour.

Whilst our street wardens have no arresting powers, they are instrumental in aiding arrests, working closely with the police and the local authority.

Working with TMI, the sister company of My Local Bobby, member businesses have access to a free private prosecution service should they wish to prosecute an offender. This is a saving of between £5,000 to £10,000 per case to a member business.

The Street Wardens and Place Ambassador make around

business visits per year in the area.

Communication is at the heart of any effective crime reduction programme. We have set up the following platforms for information sharing:



Radio Link



The Radio Link is a service provided by The Fitzrovia Partnership to reduce crime and increase the safety of members, their staff and local employees, residents and visitors. The two-way radios provide an effective and immediate means of communication and sharing information between retailers and licensed premises in accordance with the operating protocols. The Fitzrovia Partnership Street Wardens monitor and provide an immediate response to issues raised.



Business Continuity and Contingency



Working with the Metropolitan Police, local authorities, Transport for London, Public Health England, GLA and The Mayor's Office and central Government, The Fitzrovia Partnership shares best practice and advice to enable businesses to put together their business continuity and business plans.

This includes fast time intelligence and briefings during and following a major incident.




