The total number of visitors to Fitzrovia BID for the last 52 weeks is 33,617,891 which is 90.2% up on the previous year.

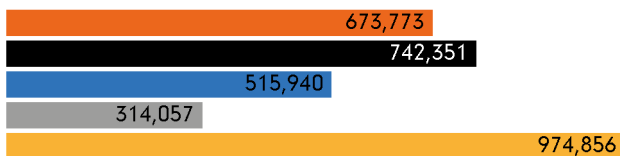
The total number of visitors for the year to date is 19,683,425 which is 102.7% up on the previous year.

Footfall by week

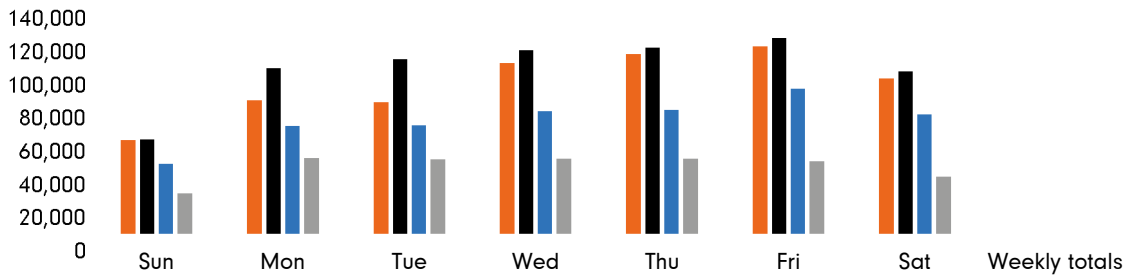

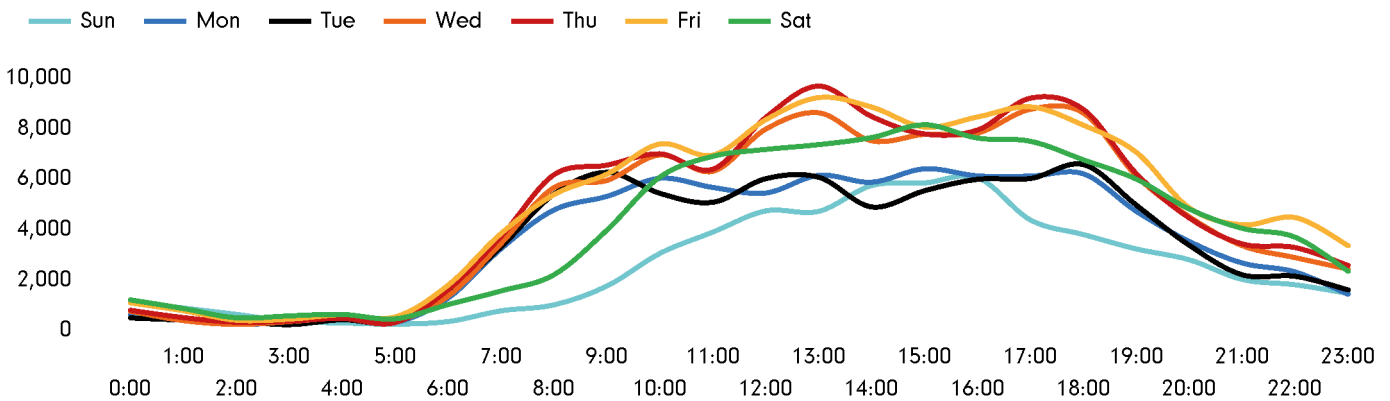

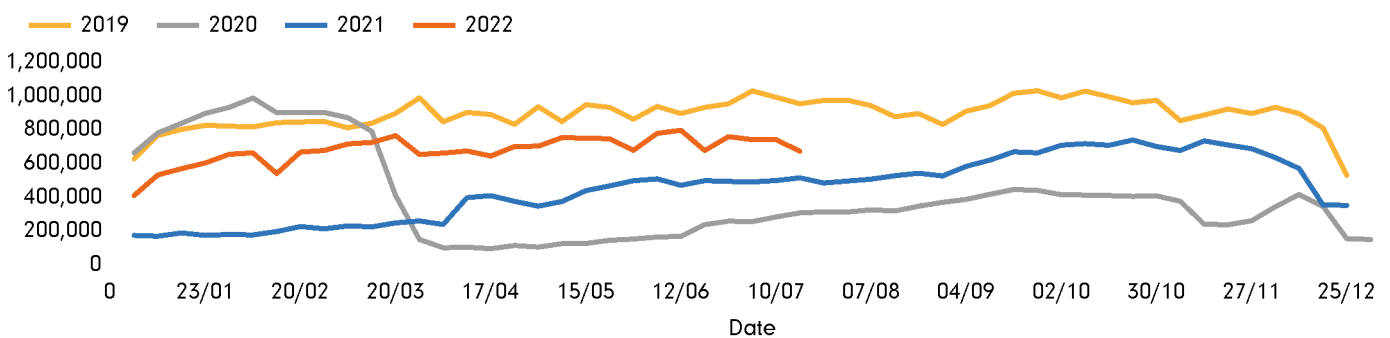

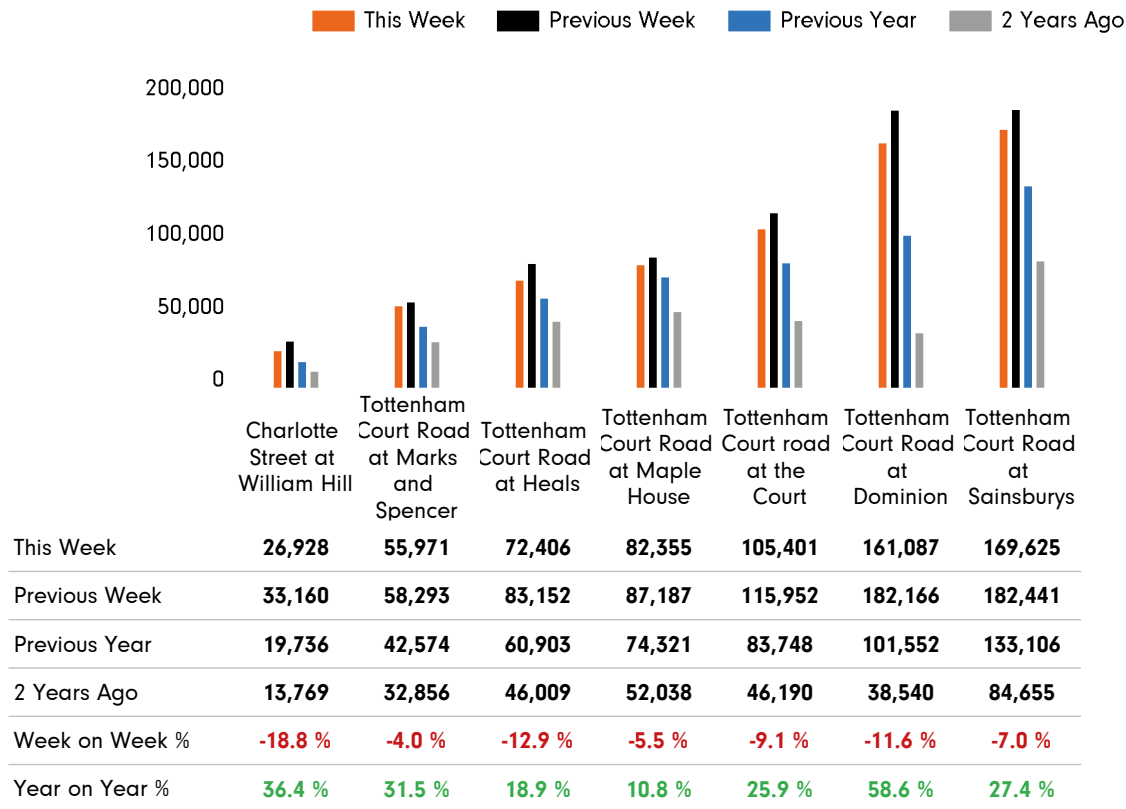
Footfall by hour

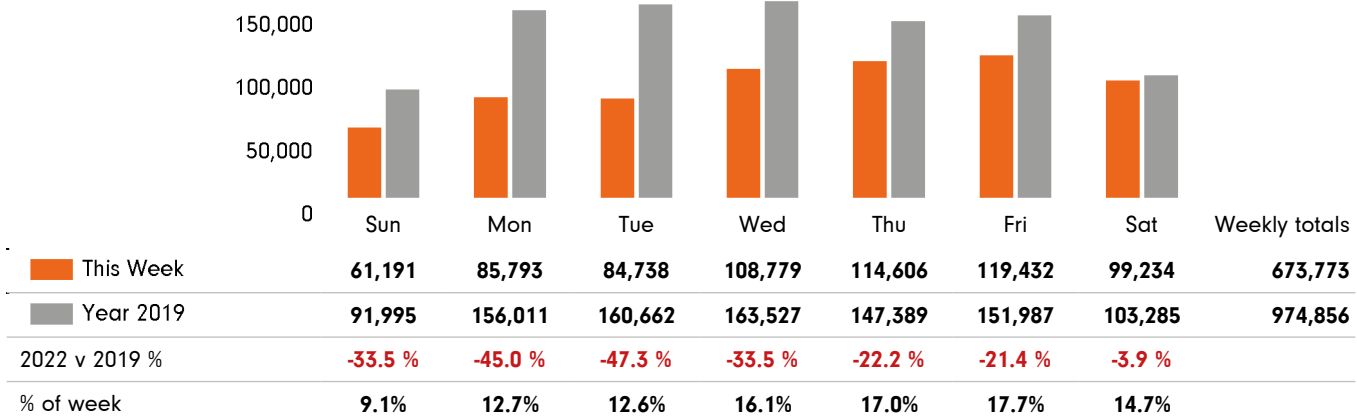
