
The total number of visitors to Fitzrovia BID for the last 52 weeks is 34,429,362 which is 87.3% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors for the year to date is 22,513,873 which is 91.9% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors to Fitzrovia BID in week commencing 14 August 2022 was 674,094.

The busiest day in week commencing 14 August 2022 was Friday with 120,234 visitors.


The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Tuesday 16 August 2022 with footfall of 9,728.






Footfall by hour


