
The total number of visitors to Fitzrovia BID for the last 52 weeks is 34,826,366 which is 84.6% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors for the year to date is 24,565,460 which is 83.5% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors to Fitzrovia BID in week commencing 4 September 2022 was 706,412.

The busiest day in week commencing 4 September 2022 was Thursday with 114,449 visitors.


The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Tuesday 6 September 2022 with footfall of 10,386.






Footfall by hour




Footfall by week


