

Summary

The final change to two-way traffic for the northern section of Gower Street between Grafton Way and Euston Road is now complete. As a reminder, please look both ways when crossing the road and use the pedestrian crossings as the safest way to cross. Traffic is no longer able to turn left from Tottenham Court Road onto Euston Road and should instead use Gower Street to access Euston Road.

Princes Circus update

The work to create a rejuvenated public space with new planting, seating, lighting and pavement at Princes Circus is continuing.

The next stage of work is to remove the old road surface on the section of road between West Central Street and Grape Street and replacing it with a new material. Paving stones and road materials have now arrived on site ready for installation.

To maintain access for businesses and residents we will be working on the road in two halves so that access will always be available.

Areas of the road will be closed between the 3rd October and the 11th November. Information has been sent to all local businesses and residents. You can find more detail on this road closure and the programme [on our website](#).

After completing the change to the road we will be working on the pavements in the area as well as starting work on the southern area of the space outside of the theatre.

West End Project 12 month Review

As promised in the original consultation for the West End Project in 2015 we have now completed a 12 month review of the West End Project following the completion of the major traffic changes. Information on this review is available [on our website](#) and includes reports on:

Gordon Square consultation


Please note the following project is not related to the West End Project but falls in the project area.

In partnership with UCL, we are consulting on possible changes to the northern side of Gordon Square outside of the Institute of Archaeology.



We are proposing to close the road in front of the Institute of Archaeology to traffic (except cycling) using planters between Gordon Street and Taviton Street.

The changes would include a two-way cycle lane, plants, seating and some bike parking. We would also provide things like a small platform for exhibitions and table tennis.
