
The total number of visitors to Fitzrovia BID for the last 52 weeks is 35,542,298 which is 76.7% up on the previous year.

The busiest day in week commencing 9 October 2022 was Tuesday with 148,523 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Tuesday 11 October 2022 with footfall of 14,336.










Footfall by hour








Footfall by location


