

Summary

The final change to two-way traffic for the northern section of Gower Street between Grafton Way and Euston Road is now complete. As a reminder, please look both ways when crossing the road and use the pedestrian crossings as the safest way to cross. Traffic is no longer able to turn left from Tottenham Court Road onto Euston Road and should instead use Gower Street to access Euston Road.

We are so pleased that the Park is picking up awards but most importantly being enjoyed by residents and visitors.




Princes Circus update

The work to create a rejuvenated public space with new planting, seating, lighting and pavement at Princes Circus is continuing.

The team have been replacing the pavement in the area. All businesses in the area have been visited to discuss access and minimising disruption as much as possible and [a letter has been sent](#) to all affected business premises.

On site at the moment the team are creating the new planting beds, adding the beautiful wooden furniture and preparing the area for the first trees and plants. Pavement areas within the site are also being created.



Windmill Square – a new pocket park for Tottenham Court Road

On Tottenham Court Road we are currently creating an improved public space at Windmill Square. This is the space on Tottenham Court Road between the junctions of Percy Street and Windmill Street. We have already added the new widened granite pavement to this area, now we are adding new places to sit alongside planting to complement the new and existing trees. These changes will improve the look at feel of the space even more, provide a new space to stop and relax and increase the local biodiversity of the area.

Work is underway with new planters and seating being installed, some of which is already open and ready to use. We expect the space to be completely opened by the end of this year.
