The total number of visitors to Fitzrovia BID for the last 52 weeks is 42,871,490 which is 14% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 40,376,035 which is 13.3% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Fitzrovia BID in week commencing 26 November 2023 was 895,206.


The busiest day in week commencing 26 November 2023 was Thursday with 159,690 visitors.









Footfall Counts by day




Footfall Counts by hour

2019 comparison for Fitzrovia BID


